

PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER 11PM the night before your procedure, unless otherwise indicated. You may brush your teeth and rinse your mouth. (DO NOT EAT GUM OR CANDY.)
- You may take your heart, blood pressure, asthma medications and/or any other medications indicated by your physician the morning of the procedure, with only a **SIP** of water.
- Discontinue ALL FISH OILS and VITAMINS, NSAIDs (such as ADVIL, IBUPROFEN, ALEVE, etc.) as well as GLP-1 (for diabetes and weight loss, such as OZEMPIC/SEMAGLUTIDE or MOUNJARO/TIRZEPATIDE) ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE.
 Also speak to your medical provider on safely stopping BLOOD THINNERS such as ASPIRIN, COUMADIN, PLAVIX, etc.
- DO NOT WEAR ANY JEWELRY OR BRING ANY VALUABLES with you on the day of the procedure.
- Every patient receiving anesthesia for their procedure MUST BE ACCOMPANIED
 HOME BY AN ADULT. Please make arrangements to have an adult accompany you,
 even if our transportation service is utilized.
- Bring photo identification and your insurance card.
- If you develop a cold, fever or symptoms of any viral illness or respiratory illness prior to the procedure, please call us immediately at **201.567.5700**.
- If you have pre-admission testing done (i.e., EKG and blood work), have your medical doctor's office email test results to EKSM370@gmail.com or fax 201.567.8049.
 ALL PRE-ADMISSION TEST RESULTS MUST BE PROVIDED VIA FAX ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE.
- All minors (under the age of 18) must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, unless other prior arrangements have been made.
- The surgical facility will contact you the day before, indicating the time you must arrive.
